

BODY LUBRICATION


The movable mechanical hardware parts of a Fisher Body are lubricated at the factory to ensure proper and quiet operation. Because of the frequent use of some parts such as door locks and door lock strikers, it is important that the readily accessible parts be lubricated at least twice a year. Other body parts should be lubricated whenever access to the parts is available.

BODY PARTS WHICH SHOULD BE LUBRICATED TWICE A YEAR

INSTRUMENT PANEL COMPARTMENT DOOR HINGE


2562, 2562DF, 2563F, 2564DF

Apply one (1) or two (2) drops of dripless oil to male and female hinge straps at locations indicated at one (1) in illustration. Wipe off excess lubricant.




DOOR JAMB SWITCH 2562, 2562DF, 2563F, 2564DF

Apply light coat of #630 AA Lubriplate or its equivalent to surface of switch plunger indicated at one (1) in illustration.




DOOR LOCK STRIKER 2562, 2562DF, 2563F, 2564DF

Wipe off dirt and apply thin coat of stick type lubricant to top surface of striker teeth indicated at one (1) in illustration. After lubrication, close door several times and remove excess lubricant along side edge of teeth.




FRONT DOOR HINGE HOLD-OPEN CLIPS 2562, 2562DF, 2563F, 2564DF

Wipe off dirt and apply light coat of #630 AA Lubriplate or its equivalent to clips indicated at one (1) in illustration.



DOOR LOCK 2562, 2562DF, 2563F, 2564DF

Wipe off dirt and apply thin coat of stick type lubricant on surface of lock bolt housing indicated at one (1) in illustration. Wipe off excess lubricant.








REAR DOOR HINGE AND HOLD-OPEN ASSEMBLY 2562, 2562DF


Wipe off dirt and apply one (1) or two (2) drops of mixture specified below to points indicated by arrows in illustration. Wipe off excess lubricant. Mixture is made up in a proportion of 1 lb. of #630 AA Lubriplate to 2 quarts of mineral spirits.




FRONT SEAT SIDE PANELS 2562, 2562DF, 2563F, 2564DF

Apply light coat of stick type lubricant along upper edge of front seat side panel indicated at one (1) in section "B-B". Wipe off excess lubricant.

The panel should be lubricated twice a year, or whenever an objectionable noise due to friction between side panel and leather seat trim is present.






GAS TANK FILLER DOOR

2562, 2562DF, 2563F, 2564DF

Apply one (1) or two (2) drops of dripless oil to hinge points indicated at one (1) in illustration. Wipe off excess lubricant.



LIFT GATE SUPPORT ASSEMBLY 2562, 2562DF, 2563F, 2564DF

Wipe off dirt and apply #630 AA Lubriplate or its equivalent over inside surface of support outer channel indicated at one (1) in Section "C-C".






BODY PARTS WHICH SHOULD BE LUBRICATED WHEN ACCESS TO PARTS IS AVAILABLE


WINDSHIELD WIPER MOTOR AUXILIARY DRIVE AND WIPER TRANSMISSION

2562, 2562DF, 2563F, 2564DF

Apply #630 AA Lubriplate or its equivalent to locations indicated at one (1) in illustration.




Lubricate moving parts of door lock with lubricant mixture made up in proportion of 1 lb. of #630 AA Lubriplate to 2 quarts of mineral spirits.



DOOR AND REAR QUARTER WINDOW REGULATOR AND CAM CHANNELS

2562, 2562DF, 2563F, 2564DF




On manual regulators, apply coat of #630 AA Lubriplate or its equivalent to rack portion of regulator sector as indicated at one (1) in illustration. On all regulators, apply #630 AA Lubriplate or its equivalent to channel portion of cam as indicated at two (2).

LIFT GATE HINGE ASSEMBLY

2562, 2562DF, 2563F

Wipe off dirt and apply #630 AA Lubriplate or its equivalent to hinge areas indicated by arrows.









LIFT GATE HINGE TORQUE RODS
